- Speeches that...
 - Have a clear message for the students
 - Relate to Georgia Tech
 - Represent your class
 - Show originality
- Content that includes something...
 - Audience appropriate
 - Humorous
 - Inspirational
 - Positive
 - Reflective
 - Connected to Georgia Tech

Speech Presentation

- What makes a good speaker?
 - You don't have to memorize your speech
 - Slow down, time yourself
 - You have 2 – 3 minutes
 - Practice – Schedule a session or two with The Naugle Communication Center
 - <https://www.communicationcenter.gatech.edu/>
 - Click the “Make Appointments Here” button and then log in using your GT info. If you haven't made an appointment before, you'll need to fill out a profile. After that, you can make an appointment (in person, by video, or written feedback only if you want help with your written draft but not speaking).

 - When filming think about being overly engaging, you want to avoid falling flat and monotone, make it look like you are enjoying yourself!

Speech Do's and Don'ts

Do's

- Have a good framework for your speech, a repetitive theme throughout that connects from beginning to end.
- Include inspiration, perhaps a little humor, motivation towards the future while celebrating this moment/achievement
- Make it unique to Georgia Tech
- Use inclusive language

Don'ts

- Talk about how miserable everything was.
- Try to replicate previous speeches.
- Include phrases like “to Hell with Georgia” or mention stealing the T.
- Give a list of 10 things you learned!
- Speak about religion

- The deadline to submit is Tuesday, Nov. 4 at 1:00 p.m.

- Video required, submit online when you apply
- Committee reviews Tuesday, Nov. 4 through Friday, Nov. 14
 - The committee consists of students, faculty, and staff
- While committee reviews, you will be sent an email requesting your availability to audition should you be selected
- Everyone will be notified Friday, Nov. 14 **late** afternoon (finalist or not)
- Auditions in-person on Wednesday, Nov. 19, 1 – 3 p.m.
 - Center for Student Engagement conference room – 3108 (student center)
 - If you are selected to audition but unable to attend, your submitted video will be played in your absence
- Everyone notified the evening after auditions – whether selected to speak or not
